## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRAND VALLEY BY-LAW NUMBER 2024 - 21

Being a By-Law to Amend By-law 09-10, as amended, known as the Zoning By-law for the Corporation of the Town of Grand Valley, to amend the By-law to deal with a Housekeeping Item – URBAN CHICKENS.

**WHEREAS** Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, as amended, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact Zoning By-laws;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grand Valley enacts as follows;

- 1. The current **Section 3.27 Illustrations** of By-law 2009-10, as amended, is hereby renumbered to **Section 3.28 Illustrations**:
- 2. A new Section 3.27 is added as follows;

## 3.27 Urban Chickens

The keeping of galliform and columbiform birds including but not limited to turkeys, chickens, quail, partridge, pheasant, peacock, guinea fowl, grouse, pigeons, doves, dodoes, and solitaires **is not permitted in any zone within the** *Urban Settlement Boundary* of the Town (as defined in the Town's Official Plan) and in the Estate Residential (ER) and Hamlet Residential (RH) zones.

The keeping of such birds is **only** permitted in the *Agricultural Area* (as defined in Town's Official Plan) of the Town within the Agricultural (A) and Rural Residential (RR) zones as a permitted *Agricultural Livestock Operation*.

In all other respects, the provisions of this By-law shall apply.
